## GET A LEG UP

Forget missionary: there are infinite positions with this furniture.

**[ NEW PRODUCT ]** Consider the new Infinity furniture series designed by Craig Alun Smith for Winnipeg's Pulse Furniture Design. While Infinity has a distinct contemporary personality, its modular be-everything-to-everyone chameleon side is what makes it stand out. Designer Smith of Cocoon Branding also created a locking metal grid system for Infinity's modular components. And unlike typical modular furniture, which tends to wobble, this grid system lends the Infinity pieces more stability. This month the series launches with a chair, sofa, loveseat and sectional, and each piece comes with variations such as block arms and tapered backs.
